TOWN OF DEERFIELD-LOCAL LAW 1-2004

Rules & Regulations of the Deerfield Town Parks

Local Law providing for the government and protection of parks in the Town of Deerfield, Oneida County, New York, hereinafter referred to as the Park and all property therein, and for the quiet enjoyment thereof by the Public, enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Deerfield as follows:

- Section 1.** The Park shall be opened to the general public between May 15th and October 15th of each year herein, between 8:00am and 9:00pm (or 10:00pm if a special extension is granted by an authorized town official).
- Section 2.** All vehicles shall be operated or parked only upon clearly marked and designated areas, at no time shall any vehicle be operated at a speed greater than five (5) miles per hour.
- Section 3.** There shall be no willful damage or destruction of Park Property. Park Property includes, but is not limited to: appliances, buildings, trees, shrubs, and amusement and convenience fixtures and appurtenances.
- Section 4.** Fires are restricted to those receptacles furnished for general public use, or in the alternative, fire boxes owned by the users, thereof. Any other open fire is forbidden at any time.
- Section 5.** All individuals or groups requesting rental of the pavilion at "Wilderness Park" must obtain a permit from the Town Clerk. The applicant will also be required to pay certain fees as established by the Town Board by Resolution from time to time.
- Section 6.** Firearms, including any type of weapon, Fireworks, Explosives, and Dangerous Instruments (as defined by Penal Law) are forbidden within the park at any time.
- Section 7.** Domestic Animals, including dogs, cats and horses, are to be leashed and under control at all times while on Park property. It shall be the duty of each animal owner or person having possession, custody or control of said animal to remove any feces left by his/her animal on any Town property.
- Section 8.** Littering is specifically prohibited and all refuse shall be deposited in receptacles placed at intervals about the park.
- Section 9.** Those persons within the boundaries of the Park, whether using its facilities or not, are subject to the rules & regulations contained herein, and may be ejected from the Park in the event they violate any rule or regulation. The leaseholder is responsible for the conduct of all guests using the Park.
- Section 10.** No connection to the electrical services is permitted, other than that for which an electrical outlet has been provided by the Town.
- Section 11.** All parties will conduct themselves with mutual respect and common courtesy for the rights of all users of the Town Park.
- Section 12.** A. A violation of this Local Law is an offense, punishable by a fine not exceeding two-hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00), or imprisonment for a period not to exceed fifteen (15) days or both said fine and imprisonment.
B. In addition to the above paragraph, any person who violates this local law may be subject to loss of any security deposit and a civil penalty in an amount not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00).
- Section 13.** The invalidation of any section of this Local Law shall not invalidate any other section or provision thereof.
- Section 14.** Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in all Deerfield Town Parks.
- Section 15.** The Local Law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.

- Applicant agrees to indemnify and hold the Town of Deerfield harmless for any damages to persons or property, including but not limited to reasonable Attorney's fees, caused in whole or in part by the acts of omission or commission of applicant, its agents, servants, employees, contractors, licensees, and invitees.
- Receipt of a copy of Local Law #1-2004, Rules & Regulations of the Deerfield Town Parks is hereby acknowledged, and there will be compliance of same in consideration of the REGISTRATION of said applicant.
- IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT ONLY THE USE OF THE PAVILLION IS RESERVED.
- The park must be vacated by all visitors within 30 minutes after closing time.

The applicant hereby acknowledges that it has provided truthful information in this application and the Town of Deerfield is relying thereon. If it is determined by the Town Board that the applicant has failed to provide truthful information on said application, the Town Board in its discretion may require the applicant to forfeit its security deposit and may be subject to further legal action.
