SECTION 1:

The purpose of this local law is to restrict smoking in public buildings and facilities of the Town, and limit smoking to certain restricted areas thereof, so as to reduce impairment of health, discomfort to the public, and nuisance to the employees of the Town and the users of the Town buildings.

2. PROHIBITION

All smoking is henceforth banned in all public buildings of the Town at all times, with the exception that smoking is permitted in designated areas as so designated by the Town Board with notice thereof given by signs clearly exhibited.

3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.

4. ENFORCEMENT

The Deerfield Constable and any other employees designated by the Deerfield Town Board shall have full authority to enforce this ordinance and to issue a summons upon any violation returnable in the Justice Courts of the Town of Deerfield.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.

4. ENFORCEMENT

The Deerfield Constable and any other employees designated by the Deerfield Town Board shall have full authority to enforce this ordinance and to issue a summons upon any violation returnable in the Justice Courts of the Town of Deerfield.

5. PENALTY

Anyone violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and upon his having been found guilty shall be subject to a fine not exceeding \$50.00 for the first offense, and \$100.00 for the second offense, and thereafter not to exceed \$250.00. The violator who fails to pay the aforesaid fines may be confined for a period up to ten days.
