

AMENDMENT OF THE ORDINANCE REGARDING SANITARY SEWER CONNECTIONS FOR THE TOWN OF DEERFIELD, NEW YORK.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Order of the Town Board of the Town of Deerfield, due notice was given in accordance with the Town law regarding a proposed amendment of the Deerfield Ordinance having to do with sanitary sewer connections, and

WHEREAS, a Hearing, pursuant to Section 130 of the Town Law, was had in this connection and was duly held before the Town Board of the Town of Deerfield, and the Town Board having duly considered all matters in connection with the problem of sanitary sewer connections, sanitary and other health and welfare matters relating to drainage and sewers, and the Town Board at a Special Meeting held April 5, 1973, having considered all of these matters at said meeting with all members having been present, the following Resolution, having been duly made and seconded, was unanimously passed amending said Ordinance effective April 5, 1973:


RESOLVED that the Ordinance of the Town of Deerfield relating to sanitary sewer connections be and it is amended as follows:

- (1.) Whenever it shall be brought to the attention of the Town Building Inspector, or a Town Health Officer, or a member of the Town Board that a health or sanitary or a hazardous condition exists, such Building Inspector, or Health Officer or member of the Town Board shall make an inspection of such condition and upon finding that a condition exists which is injurious to health, or which is unsanitary or which is hazardous to the personal safety and comfort of others


or as to those occupying the premises concerned, notice shall be given to the property owner or occupant concerned to rectify the condition within 45 days of the date of the notice and in the event that said condition is not rectified within said time, the person who maintains or who has created said condition shall be guilty of a violation and shall be punishable by a fine, not to exceed \$50.00, or imprisonment, not to exceed 15 days, or both said fine and imprisonment, and the Deerfield Town Board may invoke the remedy of injunction and any other legal remedies for the enforcement of this amendment as well as the other provisions of said Ordinance.

The aforesaid Amendment was moved by Councilman Wurz and seconded by Justice Iacovino and was unanimously passed by the "aye vote" of all of the Board, namely, Donald S. Youlen, Edward T. Wurz, Walter V. Loin, Frank P. Domser and Anthony S. Iacovino.
