**TOWN OF DEERFIELD
LOCAL LAW #1 OF THE YEAR 2009**

A Local Law providing for the removal of parked or abandoned vehicles on any public highway in the Town of Deerfield during snow storms, floods, fires or other public emergencies.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN
OF DEERFIELD, COUNTY OF ONEIDA, NEW YORK,
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: Impounding of vehicles:

Any vehicle parked or abandoned on any public highway within the Town of Deerfield during a snowstorm, flood, fire or other public emergency, or found unattended where it constitutes an obstruction to traffic or any place where stopping, standing or parking is prohibited, may be removed by or under the direction of the Town Highway Superintendent.

Section II: Storage and Charges:

After removal of any vehicle, as provided in this Local Law, the Town Highway Superintendent may provide for the storage of such vehicle in a suitable place at the expense of the owner. Such owner or person in charge of the vehicle may redeem the same upon payment of all expenses and charges actually and necessarily incurred for such removal and storage by or on behalf of the Town Highway Superintendent.

Section III: Notice of Removal:

- (a) The Highway Superintendent shall make reasonable efforts to promptly notify the owner of the vehicle of the removal of the vehicle, where it is stored and expenses to be paid to the Town in order to redeem the same.
- (b) Any vehicle not redeemed within thirty (30) days after the owner has been notified may be disposed of at public or private sale. If the owner cannot be ascertained, or notice cannot be given to the owner, then the Highway Superintendent shall cause a notice describing the vehicle to be published once in the official Town newspaper and with language to the effect that such vehicle will be disposed of after thirty (30) days if not redeemed. Thirty (30) days after publication of such notice, if the vehicle has not been redeemed, such vehicle may be disposed of at public or private sale.

Section IV. Effective Date:

This Local Law shall take affect immediately upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State.

6. (County local law concerning adoption of Charter.)
